Nomadic Pictures in Canada has joined Cineflix Studios on the new season of Copper.

The Calgary-based production company – best known western-flavoured dramas including AMC’s Hell on Wheels and the miniseries Broken Trail – said Friday it will coproduce the second season of Cineflix’s 19th century crime drama.

Nomadic co-founders Chad Oakes and Mike Frislev join the production team for the new 13x60’ season.

“Chad and Mike have built a superb reputation in this industry, especially in the world of scripted drama, with the success of the critically acclaimed Hell On Wheels,” said Vlad Wolynetz, president of production at Cineflix Studios.

Nomadic is already underway on a third season of Hell On Wheels and is also working on Klondike, Discovery Channel’s first scripted miniseries in the US.

Copper airs on BBC America and on Shaw Media’s Showcase in Canada. Pre-production is underway, with shooting expected to start next month in Toronto.
